Subject: ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaeda restrictive measures - coordination with third states

1. At its meeting on [redacted] the Working Party on restrictive measures to combat terrorism (COMET) held a discussion on a proposal for an additional listing contained in [redacted] as regards Council Decision (CFSP) 2016/1693 concerning restrictive measures against ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaeda and persons, groups, undertakings and entities associated with them.
2. As a follow up to document [redacted] approved by the Committee of Permanent Representatives on 29 June 2022, COMET agreed via written consultation that the EEAS engage with eight partner states to propose to coordinate on the above-mentioned listing.
3. In line with Council Decision 2013/488/EU on the security rules for protecting EU classified information¹, COMET agreed to propose coordination with Australia, Canada, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland, the United Kingdom and the United States, including by sharing the proposed designation, the timing for the adoption and the related evidence file, subject to the applicable agreements and arrangements which govern the exchange of classified information between the EU and the afore-mentioned third states.
