COUNCIL IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2026/1393

of 22 June 2026

implementing Article 15(1) of Regulation (EU) No 747/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Sudan

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) No 747/2014 of 10 July 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Sudan and repealing Regulations (EC) No 131/2004 and (EC) No 1184/2005 ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 15(1) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy,

Whereas:

- (1) On 10 July 2014, the Council adopted Regulation (EU) No 747/2014.
- (2) On 28 April 2026, the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) Committee established pursuant to UNSC Resolution 1591(2005) (the 'UNSC Committee') added four persons to the list of persons subject to restrictive measures.
- (3) On 7 May 2026, the Council adopted Regulation (EU) 2026/1051 ⁽²⁾ adding three of the persons listed by the UNSC Committee on 28 April 2026 to the list of natural and legal persons, entities and bodies set out in Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 747/2014.
- (4) The remaining person listed by the UNSC Committee on 28 April 2026 should also be added to the list of natural and legal persons, entities and bodies set out in Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 747/2014.
- (5) Regulation (EU) No 747/2014 should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 747/2014 is amended in accordance with the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the date of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

Reason for listing:

Al-Goney Hamdan Dagalo was listed on 28 April 2026 pursuant to paragraph 3 (c) of resolution 1591 (2005).

Information from the narrative summary of reasons for listing provided by the Sanctions Committee:

Al-Goney Hamdan Dagalo (Al-Goney) is being designated for engaging in actions or policies that threaten the peace, security, or stability of Darfur.

Al-Goney is the procurement director of the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) and a brother of Mohammed Hamdan "Hemedti" Dagalo, the leader of the RSF. Al-Goney has extended this war by leading RSF efforts to procure weapons and military materiel. By arming the RSF, his actions have directly contributed to the RSF's ongoing siege of El Fasher in North Darfur, a city of nearly two million vulnerable civilians, and the RSF's operations elsewhere in Sudan.

Al-Goney has controlled the RSF front company Tradive General Trading, which imported vehicles to Sudan on behalf of the RSF.'
